Information NC (V) Mark Sheets: November 2009 Examinations

1. General Information:

Please find enclosed the final entry schedules, admission permits and mark sheets for the National Certificate (Vocational) levels 2 – 4 for the November 2009 Examinations.

- Please ensure compliance in terms of Examination Instruction 17 of 2008.
- Final date for submission of ISAT and ICASS marks is 23 October 2009.

2. ISAT Mark Sheets:

Note that there is one mark sheet provided for each programme ISAT and not a separate mark sheet per subject for the three core compulsory vocational subjects per programme. For example, the ISAT mark for the three compulsory core vocational subjects making up the programme Electrical Infrastructure Construction Level 2 must be recorded on one mark sheet and not three separate mark sheets.

ISAT marks for subjects taken as optional vocational offerings must be recorded on individual subject ISAT mark sheets

3. Life Orientation (Paper 2) Level 2 and Level 3 Mark Sheets:

Paper 2 (Computer Literacy) for Life Orientation L2 and L3 is written on more than one day (Examination Instruction 09 of 2009). This is necessary to accommodate Examination Centres with large enrolment entries. Each Examination Centre will receive a mark sheet for the first date on which Paper 2 is to be written. All marks for Paper 2 must be recorded on this one mark sheet irrespective of the version or date on which a candidate writes Life Orientation Paper 2. However, all the examination dates for Paper 2 appear on the student examination admission permit. Examination Centres are expected to manage the writing sessions for Paper 2 internally and are required to inform candidates of the date on which they will complete Paper 2.
