Site Type	Special Needs Education (SNE)
1. Public Schools: Public schools are required to provide SNE services to all eligible students, regardless of their socioeconomic status or race/ethnicity. This includes students with physical disabilities, mental health issues, and students with specific learning disabilities. 2. Private Schools: Private schools are not required to provide SNE services, but many do so as a matter of course. This is often done through partnerships with public schools or through the school's own resources. 3. Charter Schools: Charter schools are public schools that operate independently of the local school district. They are required to provide SNE services to all eligible students, but they may have more flexibility in how they deliver these services. 4. Non-Profit Organizations: Non-profit organizations, such as the National Alliance for Public Charter Schools, provide SNE services to students in need. These organizations often focus on providing services to students who are at risk of dropping out of school.	1. Physical Disabilities: Students with physical disabilities, such as cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, and autism, are eligible for SNE services. Mental Health Issues: Students with mental health issues, such as depression, anxiety, and bipolar disorder, are eligible for SNE services. These services may include counseling, medication management, and crisis intervention. 3. Specific Learning Disabilities: Students with specific learning disabilities, such as dyslexia, dyscalculia, and dysgraphia, are eligible for SNE services.
