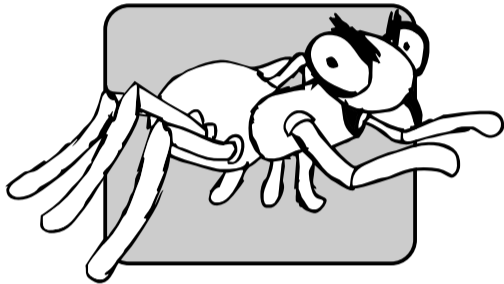
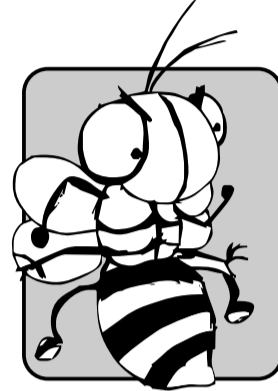
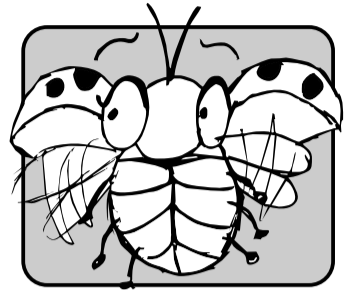
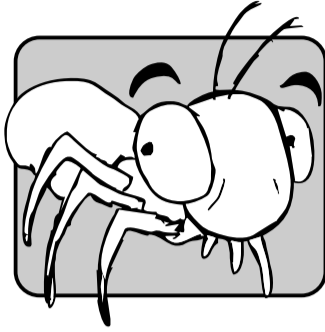
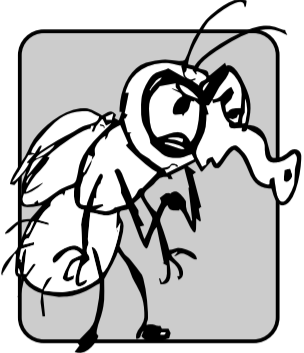


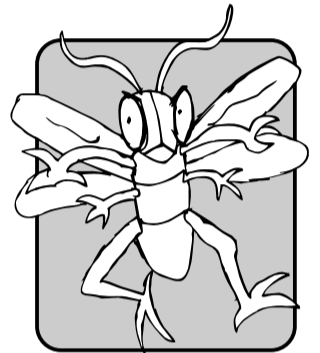
Teacher instruction:

This is a fine-motor co-ordination and reasoning activity.

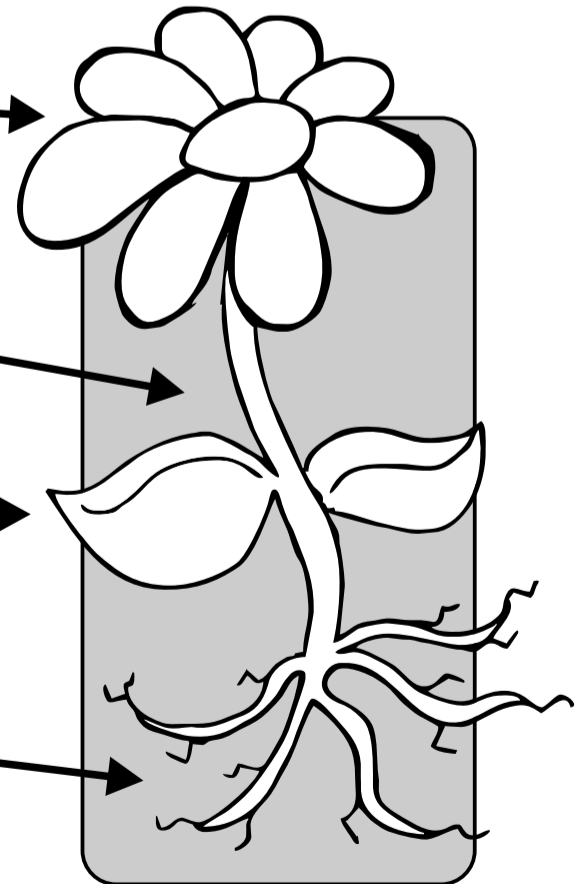
