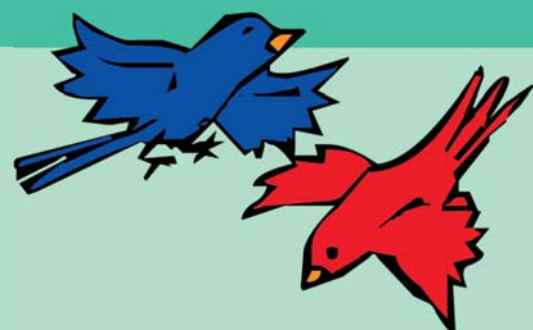


A spring surprise

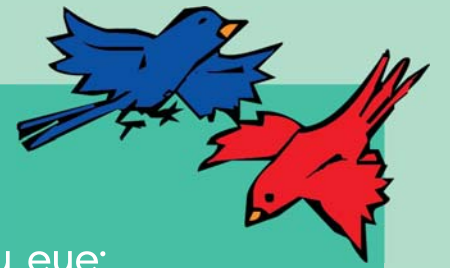
New life
