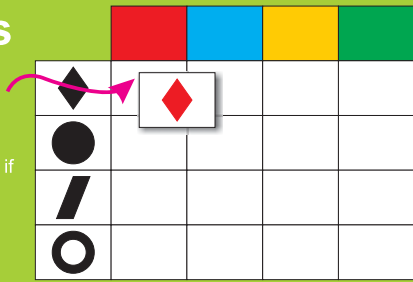


# Motshameko wa diboloko

## Teacher Notes

### Preparation:

- Cut out each board and the playing cards.
- Mount them onto cardboard and if possible laminate them.



### How to play:

- This is a game for one or two players.
- It is non-competitive – learners can work together to complete the square.
- Learners have to place the loose cards on the correct spaces on the grid.
- They do this by co-ordinating the vertical and horizontal clues, e.g. the loose red diamond card belongs on the first blank space (row 1 column 1).
