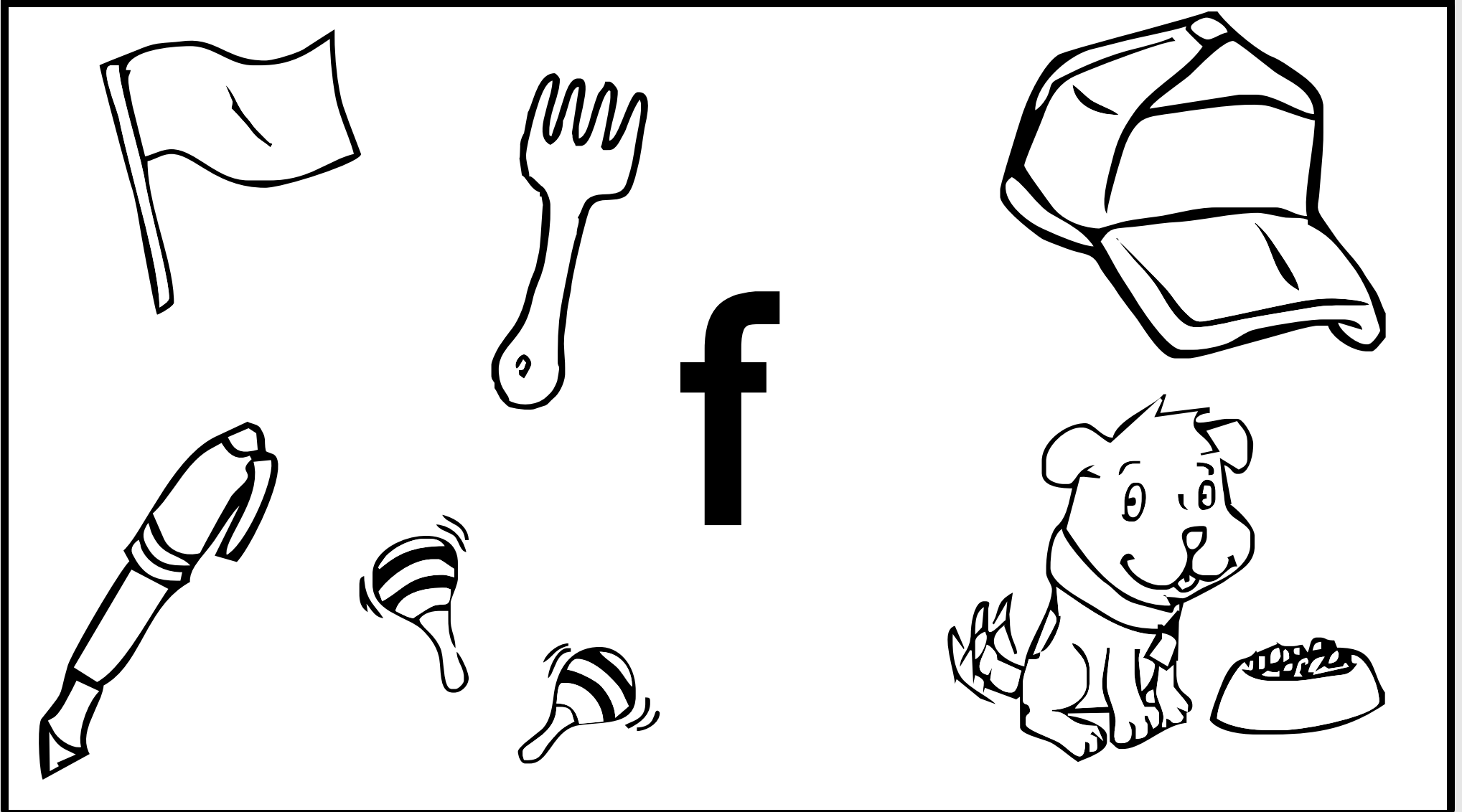


Teacher instruction:

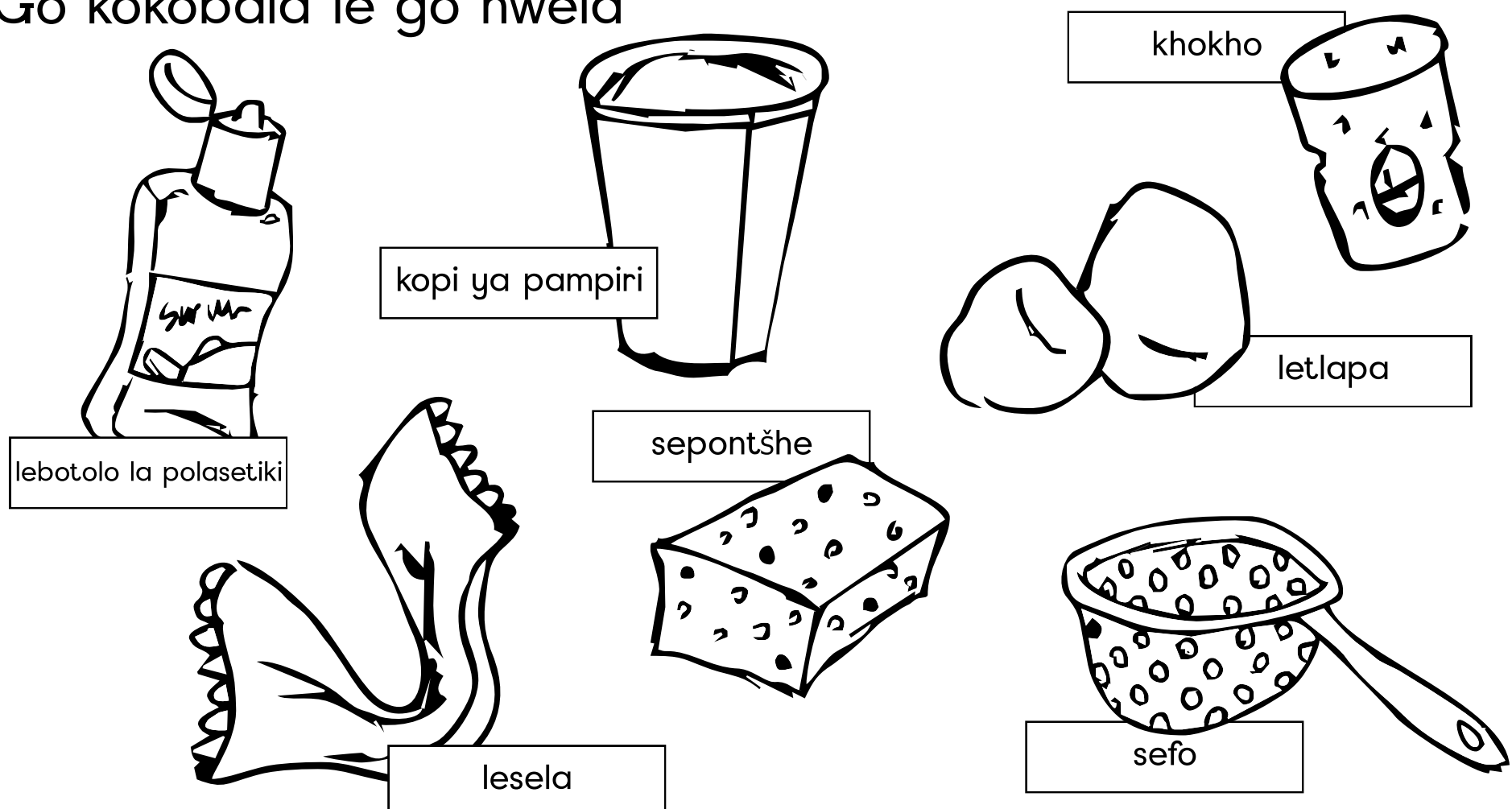
Ask learners to circle the pictures that begin with the 'f' sound.

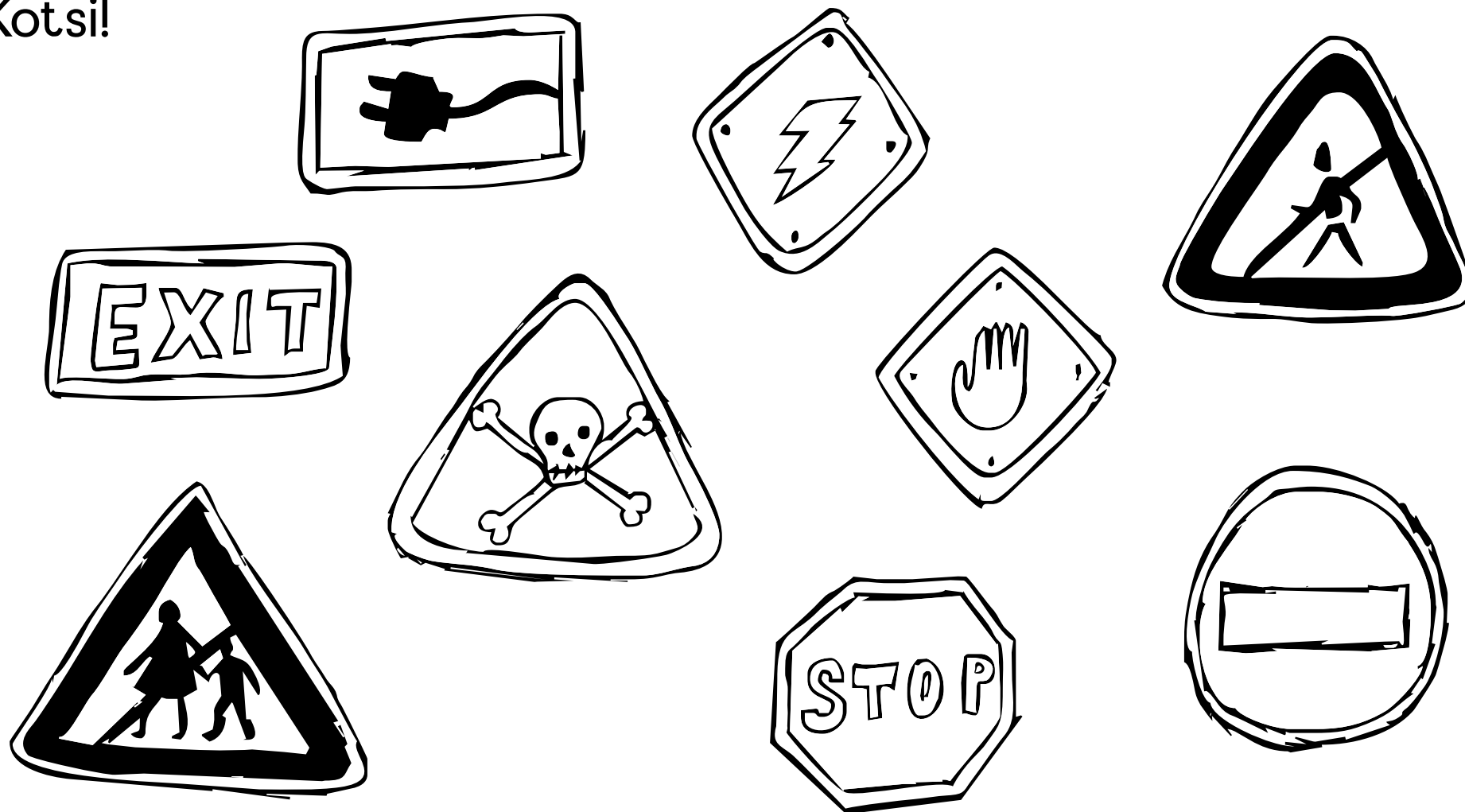
This is a pre-reading activity with strong life skill links.

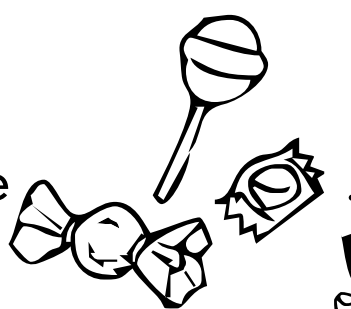

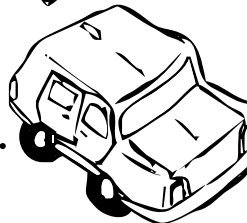

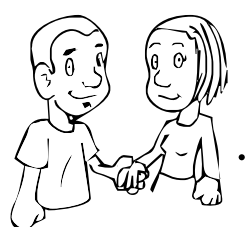
