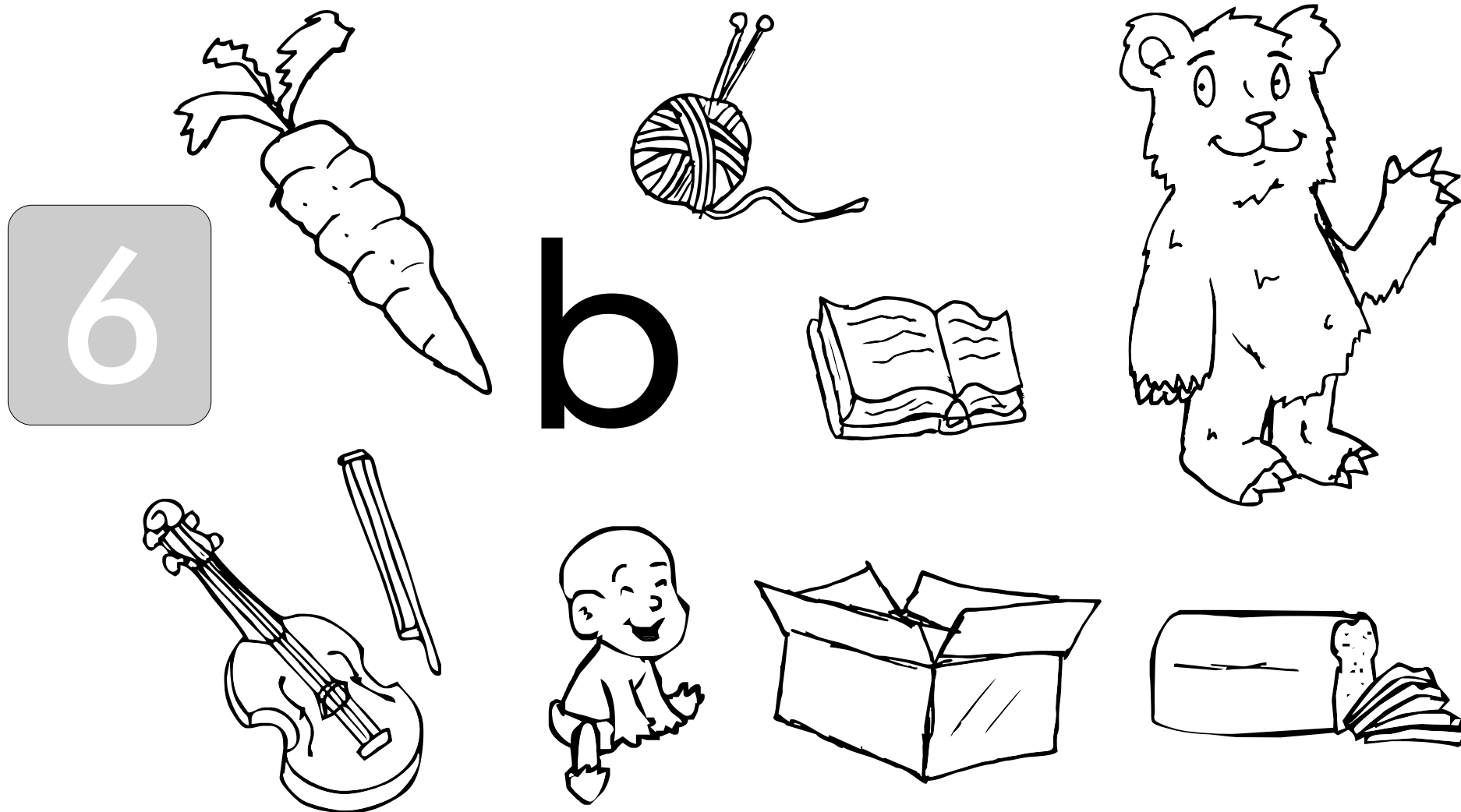


Teacher instruction:

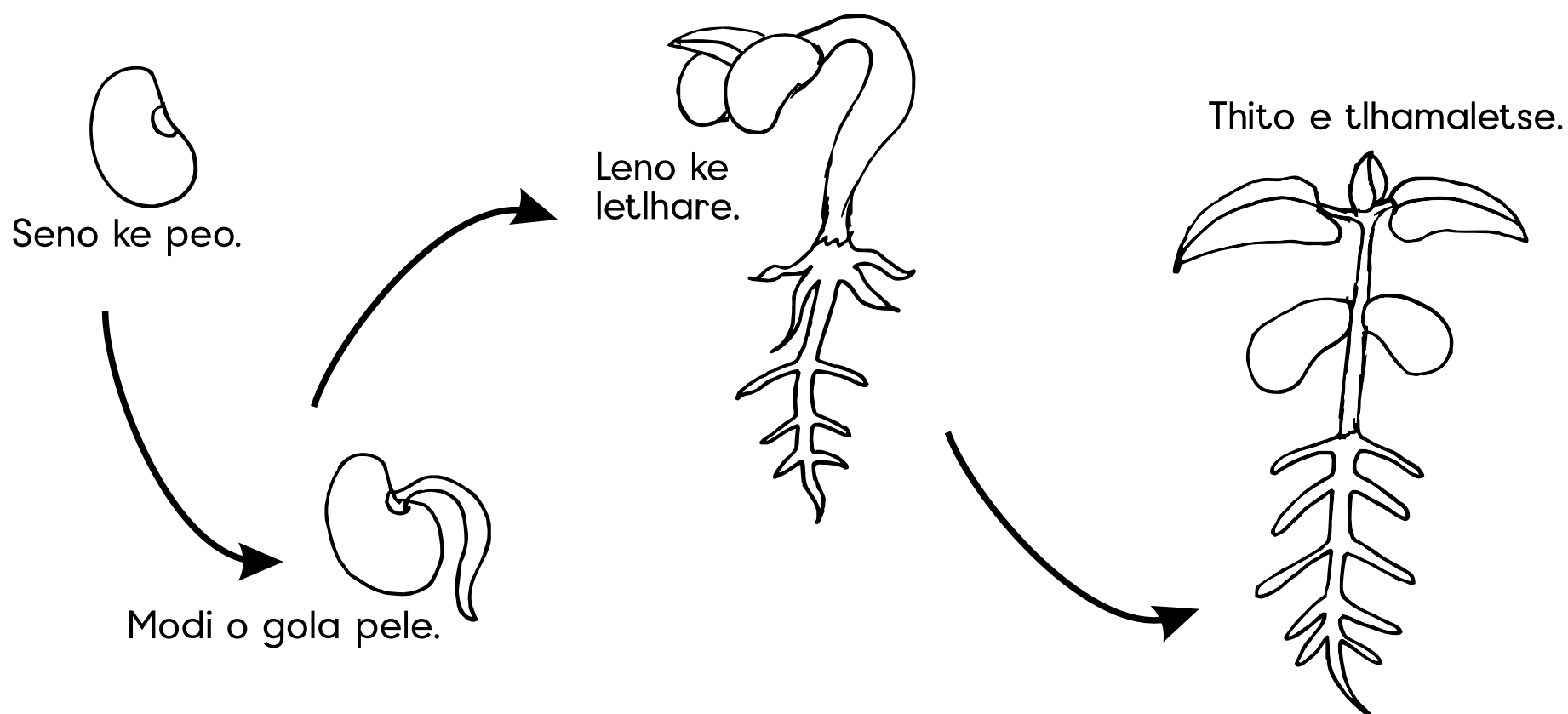
Ask learners to say the word for each picture.

This is an observation and sequencing exercise.

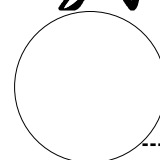
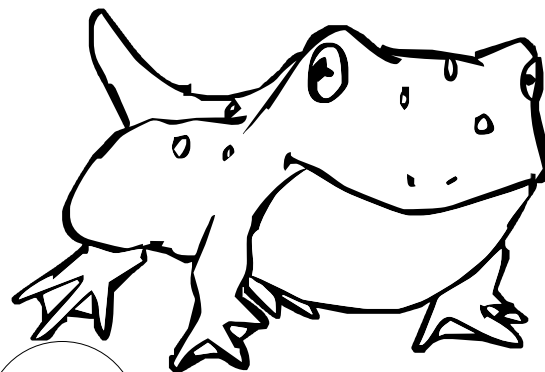
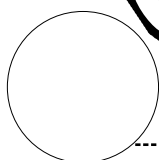
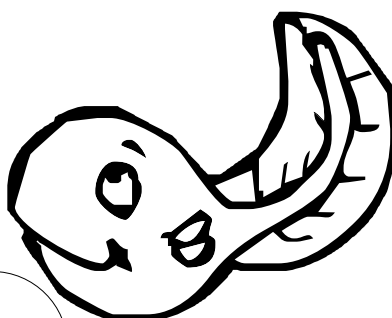
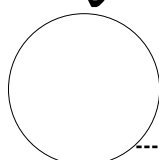
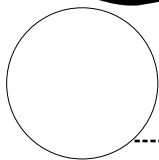
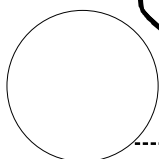
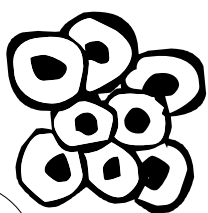

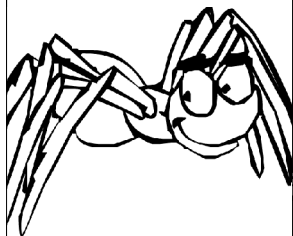
Teacher instruction:
