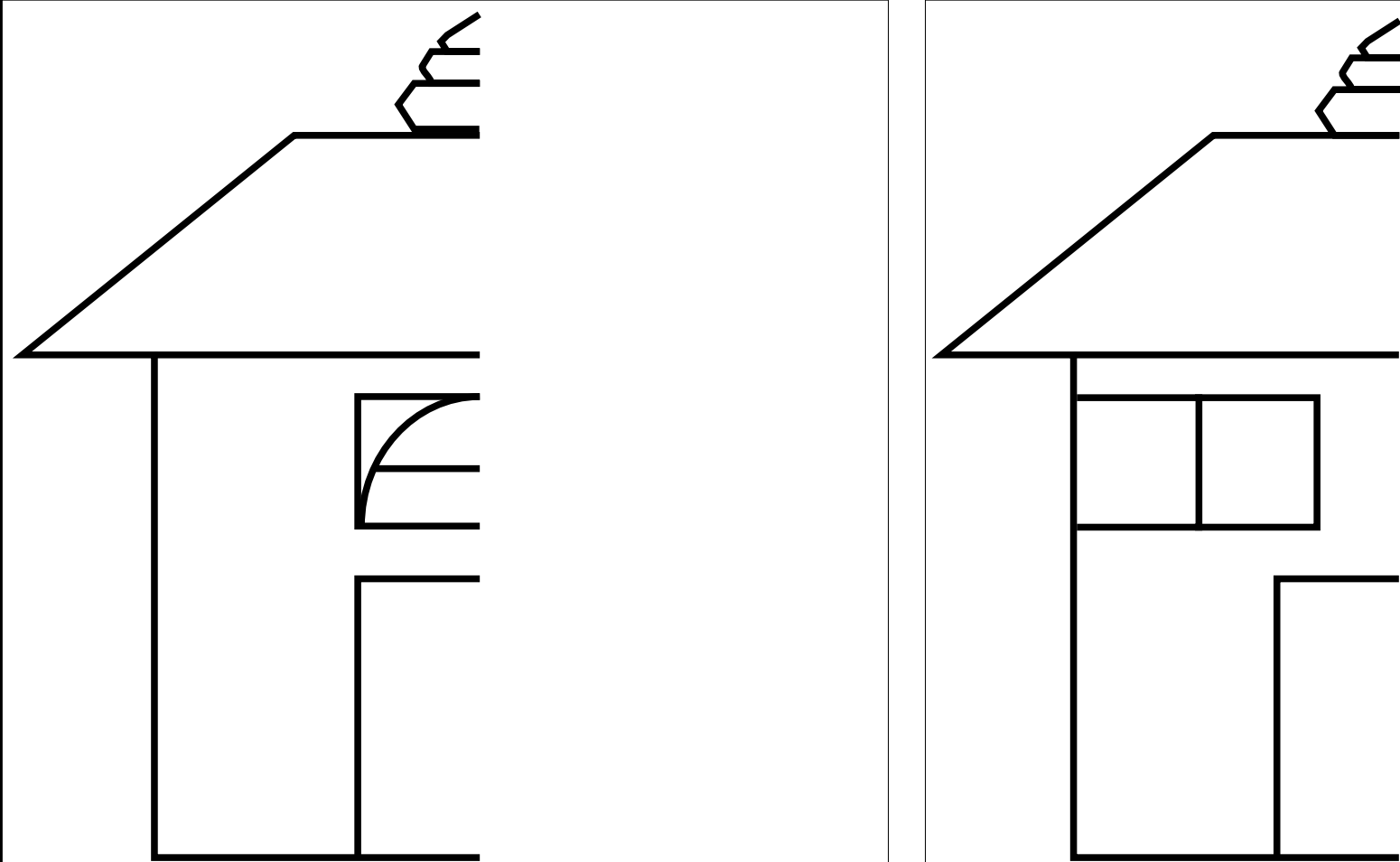


Teacher instruction:

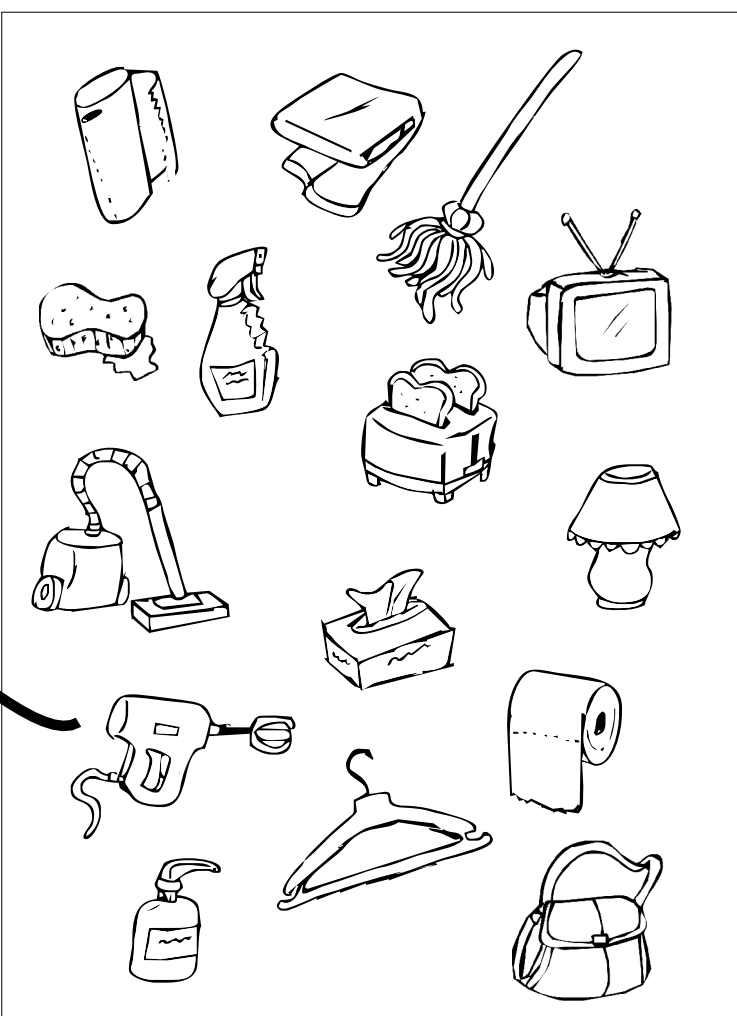


Teacher instruction:
