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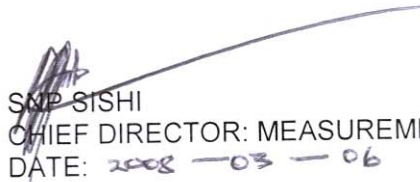

ASSESSMENT OF THE COMPUTER LITERACY COMPONENT IN THE LIFE ORIENTATION FUNDAMENTAL SUBJECT

1. The Life Orientation fundamental subject comprises a computer literacy component at certificate Levels 2, 3 and 4. To address the issue of resource utilisation the following arrangement will apply for the examination of the computer literacy component in the Life Orientation subject:
 - 1.1 All Colleges per province will write the paper between 01 to 05 September 2008.
 - 1.2 The exact date and time that the paper will be written must be determined by the province, and communicated to all students affected.
 - 1.3 The paper will be of 1.5-hour duration for Level 2 and 2 hours for Level 3.
 - 1.4 The paper will be set and moderated nationally.
 - 1.5 The Campus/College will mark all scripts internally.
 - 1.6 Marks will be recorded as part of the ICASS mark but must constitute at least 60% of the ICASS mark for Life Orientation.
2. This is to accommodate Campuses with shortage of Computers as well as load shedding.
