EXAMINATION INSTRUCTION NO. 2 OF 2009

AMENDMENT TO CONCESSIONARY MEASURES FOR ADMISSION TO SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS FOR NATIONAL CERTIFICATES (VOCATIONAL) AS STIPULATED IN THE EXAMINATION INSTRUCTION NO. 1 OF 2008

Examination Instruction No. 1 of 2008 is amended as follows:

1. All NC (V) Level 2, 3 and 4 students are eligible to write supplementary examinations in their selected subjects if they have achieved a pass in at least three subjects towards completion of subjects in a level.
2. Any NC (V) Level 2 and 3 student who writes a supplementary examination may proceed to register in the next level only if they have passed three of their subjects in the previous level.
3. A student would be allowed admission to NC(V) Level 4 only if he/she has passed at least three NC (V) Level 3 subjects ; has passed all NC(V) Level 2 subjects, and has registered to write the supplementary examinations in NC(V) Level 3.
4. All candidates who qualify are deemed to be registered and the personal time tables will be forwarded to their respective FET College/Campus.
5. All minimum promotion requirements as stipulated in the *National Policy on the Conduct, Administration and Management of the Assessment of the National Certificate (Vocational)* as set out in the schedule as National Education Policy, Gazette 30287; 12 September 2007 must be strictly adhered to.
6. Examination Instruction No. 2 of 2009 is applicable from 2009 to 2014.
