ADMISSION OF NC(V) CANDIDATES TO THE NEXT NQF LEVEL

Candidates who failed subjects during the November 2008 examinations and were eligible to write supplementary examinations in 2009 in terms of relevant examination instructions and policy and who still fail subjects in these examinations, may be allowed to continue to the next NC(V) level at the discretion of the college. The academic board of a college will make recommendations to the college principal who in turn will approve the admission of candidates to the next level based on the merits of each individual case.

The names of such candidates must be submitted to the Department of Education by 31 March 2009 so that these candidates can be registered on the system. Registration details should be submitted directly to Ms Mathilda Visser on the email visser.m@doe.gov.za or the fax number (012) 312 5804.

An NC(V) on NQF Level 4 will only be issued once a candidate has met the requirements for certification on Levels 2, 3 and 4 as per the policy for FET Programmes.

This Memorandum No. 4 of 2009 is not replacing Examination Instruction No. 2 of 2009 and provisions for supplementary examinations as stipulated in the *National Policy on the Conduct, Administration and Management of the Assessment of the National Certificate (Vocational)*. Its purpose is to assist college administration to deal with unintended consequences of the said examination instruction and policy.
