1. NSC AND N4-N6 ENTRIES FOR THE GENERAL STUDIES JUNE 2009 EXAMINATION

- The due date of entries to DoE was 20 March 2009.
- The preliminary schedules to FET Colleges will be dispatched on 15 April 2009.
- The closing date for receipt of the amended preliminary schedules to the DoE will be 27 April 2009.

2. NSC AND N4-N6 ENTRIES FOR THE GENERAL STUDIES NOVEMBER 2009 EXAMINATION

- The closing date of entries to DoE will be 10 August 2009.
- The preliminary schedules to FET Colleges will be dispatched on 01 September 2009.
- The closing date for the receipt of the preliminary schedules to the DoE will be 18 September 2009.

Once the respective entry and amendment deadline has passed, you will not be able to make any further entries, withdrawals or amendments. If you wish to request additional entries after closing dates indicated, approval needs to be obtained from the Director: Administration & Support Services, Ms EM Malindi at 012 312 5701/ 5861 or Malindi.k@doe.gov.za. The DoE reserves the right to refuse any late entry as it contravenes policy.

If approval is granted, a charge of R10.50 per candidate per subject will be applicable per late entry (Examination Instruction 02 of 2006). The DoE cannot guarantee the delivery of results on time where late entries and amendments have been made. It is the responsibility of the FET College to inform affected candidates accordingly.

Any post-examination entry received (i.e. where a candidate has not been entered but completes an examination) will constitute an irregularity and will be dealt with by the National Irregularity Committee.
