MEMORANDUM 01 OF 2012

RELEASE OF RESULTS OF REPORT 191 ENGINEERING SUBJECTS WHICH WERE UNDER INVESTIGATION – NOVEMBER 2011 EXAMINATIONS

Umalusi, the Council for Quality Assurance in General and Further Education and Training, placed an embargo on the release of results of the following six (6) Report 191 subjects pending the outcome of an investigation into the alleged leakages in these subjects during the conduct of the November 2011 examinations:

- Electrical Trade Theory N2
- Electrotechnology N3
- Engineering Science N3
- Industrial Electronics N2
- Mathematics N3
- Mechanotechnology N3

The Department undertook the investigation and presented the findings to Umalusi on 29 January 2012. The Umalusi Council studied the report and approved the release of the results as follows:

1. ELECTRICAL TRADE THEORY N2

The results of all candidates at all centres offering Electrical Trade Theory N2 may be released, except for those who may have been involved in other types of irregularities that still require investigation.

2. ELECTROTECHNOLOGY N3

The entry date for the six affected subjects has been extended to 20 February 2012 for the April 2012 examinations. All entries must be received by the Department on or before 20 February 2012.

The Department of Higher Education and Training will continue to investigate these irregularities in order to determine the source/s of the leakages in an attempt to reclaim the integrity and credibility of the examinations and assessment process.
